# A First for Puget Sound Congregation

This is not your ordinary church. The community building is rented and has excellent worship space. The chancel furniture (all handcrafted) is set up each Sunday and neatly packed and hauled away in a special trailer after each service. One could easily imagine the ancient Hebrews moving from place to place in the wilderness, relaying on their organized manpower to set up the Tabernacle wherever they found themselves.

But Living Word congregation at Puyallup, Washington, is on the move in other ways. It's quite unusual too. Their first pastor, Rev. Gary Jepsen, retired last January 1st. He was much loved in the congregation. Finding a new pastor would not be a walk in the park. After their initial search and hopes had been dashed, they decided to look for an Interim Pastor. They explored the matter, took applications and with little hesitation looked to their own membership. And there he was, Dr. Jay Thompson, a man who had faithfully taught the adult class every Sunday. He too was much loved.

He happened to be a theological professor at Faith Seminary in Tacoma. His expertise was history, especially Reformation and church history, along with Greek. He is now Professor of Church History and Exegesis and represents Faith Seminary to the LCMC.

But it takes more than a fine education and teaching talents to lead the Lord's flock. Jay knew this, of course. And with God's leading he had been preparing for pastoral ministry over several years. Five years earlier Jay asked for and received a Certification Interview. He was approved without hesitation to serve as an LCMC pastor.

That was significant not just for him but for LCMC members here in Western Washington. Why? Out here, in un-believer land, this has never happened before. On March 22nd Jay Thompson became the first newly-ordained certified LCMC pastor to serve the mission field that baldly defines us in the Puget Sound area. Certainly, he was the first to serve the same congregation where he and his family were already members.

Talked about the Call of God! There is much joy at Living Word Lutheran Church in Puyallup! Pastor Thompson will serve them until they and that person God is preparing for them. Surely, the Lord will till the soil of their hearts and minds and lead them to that pastor who receives and accepts their Call on a permanent basis.
