## LCMC Northwest District Gathering April 20 & 21, 2018


Here at Christ Community Lutheran Church, Lebanon, OR we are looking forward to hosting the 2018 LCMC Northwest District Gathering.

## Central Lutheran Church — Morton, Washington

Central Lutheran was founded Feb. 28, 1954 and the church was built June 1,1955. We are in a logging area that is predominately Scandinavian and German with a mixture of other cultures.

Our congregation is 95% older/retired members and our worship style is Traditional/Formal. We have a membership of about 60-75. Currently Pastor Greg Wightman is serving us part-time.

We offer a Sunday morning Bible study and a Women's Bible study every Thursday. The second

Sunday of each month we hold a worship service at the Heritage House Nursing and Retirement Community. On the second and fourth Tuesdays we are involved with Project Linus.



## Bethany Lutheran Church — Bigfork, Montana

On April 13,1918, the Bethlehem and Swan River congregations merged to form Bethany Norwegian Lutheran church.

On June 25, 1961, ground was broken and the first worship service in the present building was held on Reformation Sunday, October 29, 1961.

We have three women's Bible study

groups, Quilting Ministry, Prayer Team, Visitation Care Team, Choir, Sunday school, just to name a few. Currently serving us is Pastor Christopher Miller. "Bethany Lutheran Church is a community that is seeking to share the Gospel of Christ with the entire Flathead Valley."

A Mobile Medical Unit serves the surrounding areas that include Sweet Home, Scio, Halsey and Brownsville.
