2016 Annual Gathering Business Meeting

- * Gathering opened at 3:04 PM with a welcome by Pat Woods, Chairman.
- * Pat explained how the Gathering would run and gave facility directions.
- * Introduction of the 2015-2016 Board and notification that three board members would be leaving their positions, making a total of 4 open positions to be filled by general election of the gathering.
- * Pat announced that our current Web-Master will be resigning in December. This is an important paid position. Pat prayerfully asked all who have ability to give considerable thought to filling this position.
- * Our offering beneficiary was identified as the Chelan-Douglas Community Action Council. This is a locally run 501(c)3 charitable organization serving the needs of at least twelve associations in the surrounding area. This location has suffered much with the summer 2016 fires, and many peoples and charities are struggling to build up their resources again.
- * Pastor Murray Stanton briefed the gathering on how to write the checks for the charity receiving our offerings and he also explained how to donate dollars to the Northwest District. He covered the fact that belonging to National LCMC does not automatically enroll you as a member of the NW District, nor does any funds that you donate to National come rolling down to our organization. All donations must be made out specifically to the NW District in C/O Kathy Nida, our Treasurer.
- * Business meeting opened at 9:00 AM the following morning, and a quorum was met for any business items presented for vote.

- * Minutes were printed in the membership package distributed on arrival. Motion was M/S/P to approve the minutes as presented.
- * Treasurer report was presented by Murray Stanton. On December 31, our banking balance was \$20,367.86. Details of expenses and revenue were discussed and a motion as M/S/P to accept the report. The gathering floor felt that more detail was needed at the next gathering. That will be discussed in future board meetings.
- . * Kim Weist of Odessa has set up a Facebook page NW Lutherans, check it out.
- * Pat called for nominations from the floor to fill the four council positions open. Five names were submitted and all five agreed to serve, if elected. As there were more nominations than positions, it was decided to conduct a written ballot to resolve the election. After a duly conducted count, Pastor Eric Hullstrom, Suzanne Robinson, Denel Ingraham, and Dr. Lee Wicklund were elected to serve three year terms on the Council.
- * Sarah Stanton, Misty Redlin, Mary Stubblefield, and Jeff Redlin, along with Shelly Hauge as an advisor volunteered to serve on next year's Gathering Committee.
- * Gathering closed after worship at 7:44 PM.

April 2016 Board Meeting

- * Devotions were dispensed with as we would be worshiping later.
- * Motion was M/S/P to accept the Executive Board members as a slate: Pat Woods/Chairman, Murray Stanton/ Vice Chair, Barb Fagley/Secretary, and Kathy Nida/Treasurer. Sub-Committee positions will be assigned at our next meeting.
- * Motion was M/S/P to accept two new congregations into the NW District. Welcome to Good Hope Lutheran of Lenore, ID and Little Missouri Lutheran of Capitol, MT. We await a Chapter application from St. Paul Mission Congregation in Idaho also.
- * Motion was M/S/P to give Kathy Nida authority to dispense all funds needed to pay gathering expenses up to the previously approved amount.
 - * Dates and locations for the next three meetings were decided.
 - Next District Council we be: July 18, 2016
 Meeting at: Holy Trinity Lutheran Church Spokane Valley, WA
- * Noted that our District Coordinator, Moe Bessey, will complete her term of service in April 2017. This position will be open for perspective volunteers.


